RESTRICTION OF TRAVEL ACTIVITIES IN EXITING AND / OR ENTERING THE SPECIAL CAPITAL REGION OF JAKARTA PROVINCE IN THE MITIGATION OF THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

WITH THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

GOVERNOR OF SPECIAL CAPITAL REGION OF JAKARTA

Considering

- : a. whereas the enactment of Large-Scale Social Restrictions has reduced the number of cases and the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province;
 - b. whereas in order to increase preparedness and prevent the emergence of new cases of the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) during the period of the stipulation of the non-natural disaster of the Spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a national disaster as stipulated in Presidential Decree Number 12 of 2020, efforts are required to restrict travel activities for every person who exits and/or enters the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province;
 - whereas to provide legal certainty and protection for the community carrying out activities during the restriction of travel activities for every person who exits and/or enters the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province, it is necessary to be regulated by a Governor Regulation;
 - d. whereas based on the considerations as referred to in letter
 a, letter b and letter c, it is necessary to stipulate a Governor
 Regulation regarding Restriction of Travel Activities In
 Exiting and / or Entering the Special Capital Region of



Jakarta Province in Preventing the Spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Covid-19);

- Law Number 29 of 2007 regarding the Government of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province as the Capital of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 93 of 2007, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4744);

- Law Number 6 of 2018 regarding Health Quarantine (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 128 of 2018, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6236);
- Government Regulation Number 21 of 2020 regarding Large-Scale Social Restrictions to Accelerate Mitigation of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 91 of 2020, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6487);

: GOVERNOR REGULATION REGARDING RESTRICTION OF TRAVEL ACTIVITIES IN EXITING AND / OR ENTERING THE SPECIAL CAPITAL REGION OF JAKARTA PROVINCE IN THE MITIGATION OF THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

In this Governor Regulation, what is meant by:

- 1. Large-Scale Social Restrictions (*Pembatasan Sosial Berskala* Besar) hereinafter abbreviated as PSBB are restrictions on certain activities for residents in an area suspected of being infected with the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in such a way as to prevent the possibility of the spreading of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- 2. Task Force for the Acceleration of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Mitigation in the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province, hereinafter referred to as the Provincial level COVID-19 Task Force is the Task Force for the Acceleration of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Mitigation formed by the Provincial Government of DKI Jakarta at the Provincial level.
- 3. Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province, Bogor City/Regency, Depok City, Tangerang City/Regency, South Tangerang City, and Bekasi City, hereinafter referred to as Jabodetabek, are areas of agglomeration that impose large-scale social restrictions to prevent the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) based on stipulation by the Central Government.
- 4. Electronic Resident Identity Card, hereinafter abbreviated as KTP-el, is a resident identity card equipped with a chip which is the official identity card of residents as proof of self that is issued by the implementing agency.
- 5. Exit / Entry Permit, hereinafter abbreviated as SIKM (*Surat Izin Keluar Masuk*), is a letter given as dispensation to be able to go out of and/or into the DKI Jakarta Province during the stipulation of the non-natural disaster of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a national disaster.

- 6. Decree for Administrative Fine on the Restriction of Travel Activities Exiting and/or Entering the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province hereinafter abbreviated as SKDA-PKB, is a decree that determines the amount of the administrative fine that must be paid by land transportation providers that are deposited into the regional treasury due to its violation to the enactment of restrictions of travel activities in exiting and/or entering DKI Jakarta Province.
- 7. The Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province, hereinafter referred to as the DKI Jakarta Province, is a province that has specificity in the administration of regional governance due to its position as the Capital of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.
- 8. Provincial Government of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta, hereinafter referred to as the Provincial Government of DKI Jakarta, shall be the Governor and regional apparatus of the DKI Jakarta Province as the element of government administrator of the DKI Jakarta Province.
- 9. Governor is the is the Head of the DKI Jakarta Province who due to his/her position is also a representative of the Government in the DKI Jakarta Province.
- 10. Police Force is the Police Force of the Republic of Indonesia.
- 11. The Indonesian National Army hereinafter abbreviated as TNI is the National Army of the Republic of Indonesia.
- 12. Capital Investment and One-Stop Integrated Services Service Office hereinafter referred to as the DPM and One-Stop Integrated Services Service is the Capital Investment and One-Stop Integrated Services Service in the DKI Jakarta Province.
- 13. The Pamong Praja Police Unit, hereinafter referred to as the Satpol PP, is the DKI Jakarta Province Pamong Praja Police Unit.
- The Health Service Office is the DKI Jakarta Provincial Health Service Office.
- 15. The Transportation Service Office is the DKI Jakarta Provincial Transportation Service Office.
- 16. City/Regency Administration is the 5 (five) City Administrations and Regency Administrations of Kepulauan Seribu in the DKI Jakarta Province.
- 17. The Neighborhood Unit, hereinafter abbreviated as RT, are Neighborhood Units in DKI Jakarta Province.
- 18. The Community Unit, hereinafter abbreviated as RW, are Community Units in the DKI Jakarta Province.



19. Bank DKI is the Bank DKI Limited Liability Company which is a Regional Government-Owned Enterprise of the DKI Jakarta Provincial Government.

CHAPTER II

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

Article 2

This Governor Regulation has the purpose to serve as a guideline for implementing restrictions for travel activities in exiting and/or entering DKI Jakarta Province in an effort to prevent the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

Article 3

This Governor Regulation aims to:

- a. prevent and ward off the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), both inside and outside the DKI Jakarta Province that can potentially create new cases of the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 20 19 (COVID-19);
- b. restricting the movement of people exiting and/or entering the DKI Jakarta Province in order to suppress the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); and
- c. provide legal protection and certainty for the community and the Task Force for the Acceleration of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Mitigation in the DKI Jakarta Province in an effort to support the prevention of the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

CHAPTER III

RESTRICTION OF TRAVEL ACTIVITIES

- (1) Every person or business actor shall be prohibited from carrying out travel activities exiting and/or entering the DKI Jakarta Province during the stipulation of the nonnatural disaster of the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a national disaster.
- (2) Every person or business actor violating the provisions referred to in paragraph (1) shall be subject to the following actions:



- a. If originating from the DKI Jakarta Province they are directed to return to their home/residence, and
- b. If originating from outside of the DKI Jakarta Province they are directed to return to their place of origin or are to be quarantined for 14 (fourteen) days at the location designated by the Task Force for the Acceleration of the COVID-19 Mitigation at the Provincial and/or Administrative City/Regency level.
- (3) Prohibition for travel activities in exiting and/or entering the DKI Jakarta province as referred to in paragraph (1) does not apply to:
 - a. Persons or business actors who have a Jabodetabek KTP-el; and
 - b. Foreigners who have Jabodetabek KTP-el/permanent stay permit/limited stay permit,

with the destination to and/or return from areas in Jabodetabek.

CHAPTER IV

EXEMPTIONS TO THE RESTRICTION OF TRAVEL ACTIVITIES

Section One

Exiting/Entering Travel Activities for Exempted Sectors

- (1) Exempt from the prohibition of carrying out travel activities in exiting and/or entering the DKI Jakarta Province as referred to in Article 4, for:
 - a. heads of high state institutions;
 - b. Foreign Country Representative Corps and/or International Organizations in accordance with international law;
 - c. members of the TNI and Police Force:
 - d. toll road officers;
 - e. officers for the handling the prevention of the spread of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), including medical personnel;



- f. firefighters, ambulances, and hearses;
- g. drivers of the cars carrying goods without passengers;
- h. drivers of vehicles transporting drugs and medical devices;
- i. patients who need emergency health services and their companions; and
- j. every person, business actors, or foreigners who because of their duties and work have SIKM.
- (2) The category of persons, business actors or foreigners who because of their duties and work can have SIKM as referred to in paragraph (1) letter j, refers to the sector that is exempted from the provisions of the laws and regulations concerning PSBB, namely:
 - a. all government offices/institutions, both central and regional, based on arrangements by the relevant ministries;
 - b. Foreign Country and/or International Organization Representative Offices.
 - c. State/Regional-Owned Enterprises that participate in the mitigation of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and/or in meeting the basic needs of the community following the arrangements from the relevant ministries, the Provincial Government of DKI Jakarta;
 - d. business actors engaged in the following sectors:
 - 1. health:
 - foodstuff/food/beverage;
 - 3. energy;
 - 4. communication and information technology;
 - 5. finance;
 - 6. logistics;
 - 7. hospitality;
 - 8. construction:
 - 9. strategic industries:
 - 10. basic services, public utilities, and industry stipulated as national vital objects and certain objects; and/or
 - 11. daily needs.
 - e. local and international community organizations engaged in the disaster and/or social sector.



Article 6

- (1) Every person, business actors or foreigners who because of their duties and work can have SIKM as referred to in Article 5 paragraph (1) letter j, by filling the application form online through the *corona.jakarta.go.id* and fulfilling the following requirements:
 - a. an introduction letter from the Head of the RT that is known to the Head of the RW where they live;
 - b. a statement of health with stamp duty;
 - c. statement letter:
 - 1. on a business trip out of Jabodetabek;
 - 2. a statement letter of work for every person whose place of work is outside of Jabodetabek; or
 - the business actor is equipped with a statement letter of having a business outside Jabodetabek known by an authorized official; and
 - d. for foreigners having an KTP-el / permanent stay permit.
- (2) If the application as referred to in paragraph (1) is declared complete, DPM and One-Stop Integrated Services can issue SIKM electronically in the form of a QRcode.
- (3) The format of the requirements referred to in paragraph (1) can be downloaded through *corona.jakarta.go.id.*

Section Two

Activities of Travelling into the DKI Jakarta Province

Article 7

(1) Every person, business actor, or foreigner who due to their duties and work and/or emergency reasons travels into DKI Jakarta Province from outside Jabodetabek must have SIKM during the period of the stipulation of non-natural disasters of the spread of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a national disaster.



- (2) The requirement to have SIKM as referred to in paragraph (1) by filling out the application form online through *corona.jakarta.go.id* and completing the following requirements:
 - a. having a DKI Jakarta KTP-el or a DKI Jakarta Family Card, but domiciled outside Jabodetabek; or
 - b. for foreigners who have an KTP-el/permanent stay permit; and
 - c. a statement of health with stamp duty.
- (3) For people who do not have a DKI Jakarta KTP-el or a DKI Jakarta Family Card can have a SIKM by filling out the application form online through corona.jakarta.go.id and completing the following requirements:
 - a. having a certificate from the sub-district/village where the travel originated explaining the purpose and objectives of coming to DKI Jakarta Province;
 - b. a statement of health with stamp duty;
 - c. having a security certificate with stamp duty from a family in the DKI Jakarta Province known by the head of the local RT or a security certificate with stamp duty from a company in the DKI Jakarta Province;
 - d. for applicants with a business travel to attach a statement from the workplace in the DKI Jakarta Province; or
 - e. for applicants who for emergency reasons travel into DKI Jakarta Province to submit a certificate of domicile of residence from the sub-district in the DKI Jakarta Province.
- (4) If the application form as referred to in paragraph (2) and paragraph (3) is declared complete, DPM and One-Stop Integrated Services can issue SIKM electronically in the form of a QR-code.
- (5) The issuance of SIKM shall apply with the following provisions:
 - a. issuance 1 (one) working day since the application along with all the required documents are declared complete online;
 - b. valid for 1 (one) applicant; and
 - c. for children who do not have an KTP-el following the SIKM of their parent or one of the family members.
- (6) The format of the requirements as referred to in paragraph (2) and paragraph (3) can be downloaded through *corona.jakarta.go.id*.

Article 8

(1) If a person does not own an SIKM as referred to in Article 7 paragraph (1) and is already in DKI Jakarta Province shall be imposed with the following actions:



- a. directed to return to the place of origin of the travel; or conduct a quarantine for 14 (fourteen) days at a place designated by the Provincial and/or City/Regency level Task Force for the Acceleration of COVID-19 Mitigation.
- (2) If necessary for people who are in quarantine as referred to in paragraph (1) letter b, health examination shall be conducted periodically by Health Service Office officials.

Section Three

Types of SIKM

- (1) Types of SIKM as referred to in Article 6 and Article 7 consist of:
 - a. a repetitive travel SIKM; or
 - b. a one-time travel SIKM.
- (2) A repetitive travel SIKM as referred to in paragraph (1) letter a, is intended for:
 - employees/workers, business actors, or foreigners who are domiciled in DKI Jakarta Province, but the place of work/place of business is outside Jabodetabek; or
 - b. employees/workers, business actors, or foreigners domiciled outside Jabodetabek, but the place of work/place of business is in the DKI Jakarta Province.
- (3) A one-time travel SIKM as referred to in paragraph (1) letter b, is intended for:
 - a. employees/workers, business actors, or foreigners who travel outside Jabodetabek; or
 - b. people, business actors, or foreigners who are domiciled outside Jabodetabek, but have:
 - a place of residence or place of business in DKI Jakarta Province; or
 - urgent needs, including travel of patients who need emergency health services or travel of people whose core family members are terminally ill or deceased.



Section Four

Verification

Article 10

- (1) In the issuance of SIKM as referred to in Article 6 and Article 7, the DPM and One-Stop Integrated Services shall carry out verification to ensure the completeness of documents.
- (2) In conducting the verification, DPM and One-Stop Integrated Services can include:
 - a. Manpower, Transmigration, and Energy Service Office;
 - b. demographic affairs and Civil Registry Service Office;
 - c. Satpol PP;
 - d. Industry, Trade, Cooperatives, Small and Medium Enterprises Service Office:
 - e. Tourism and Creative Economy Service Office; and
 - f. Communication, Information, and Statistics Service Office,

in accordance with the needs and capabilities of DPM and One-Stop Integrated Services.

Article 11

The format of the statement letter, the format of the explanation letter, the format of the application form, and the procedure for issuance of SIKM as referred to in Article 6 and Article 7 shall be stipulated by a Decree of the Head of DPM and the One-Stop Integrated Services.

Section Five

Criminal Sanctions

Article 12

Every person or business actor who makes fake letters, manipulates information and/or electronic documents, falsifies letters, or makes false statements for the administration of SIKM shall be subject to criminal sanctions in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations.



CHAPTER V

SUPERVISION AND ENFORCEMENT

Article 13

- (1) Supervision and enforcement of violations of the restrictions on travel activities in entering and exiting the DKI Jakarta Province as referred to in Article 4, Article 5, Article 7 and Article 8, shall be carried out by Satpol PP with assistance from the Transportation Service Office and may include elements of the Police Force and the TNI.
- (2) Supervision as referred to in paragraph (1), shall be carried out by placing the coordination posts as check points.
- (3) The check points as referred to in paragraph (2) shall be carried out at the following location:
 - a. access roads exiting and entering the DKI Jakarta Province, both toll roads and non-toll roads:
 - b. terminal bus of passenger transportation;
 - c. exit/entrance of inter-city train station;
 - d. exit/entrance of airport passenger terminal; and
 - e. exit/entrance of seaport passenger terminal.
- (4) In carrying out supervision at check points, health examination by officers of the Health Service Office can be carried out.

- (1) To support the effectiveness of the implementation of supervision in the residential environment, the RT officers shall monitor migrants entering the DKI Jakarta Province.
- (2) In the event that the RT officers discover migrants who do not have and cannot show an SIKM, they are required to report to the Head of Sub-District through the Task Force for the Acceleration of COVID-19 Mitigation at the RW level.
- (3) The Head of Sub-District who receives a report from the RW level COVID-19 Task Force as referred to in paragraph (2), must direct the migrants to conduct a health examination at the local health service facility.
- (4) If the results of the health examination as referred to in paragraph (3) show signs of symptoms of experiencing the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), the Head of Sub-District must quarantine the migrants in the place designated by the



Task Force for the Acceleration of COVID-19 Mitigation at the City/Regency Administration level.

(5) Funding for basic necessities during quarantine as referred to in paragraph (4), in the form of food, drink and other basic necessities shall be borne by the migrants.

CHAPTER VI

PROHIBITION FOR LAND TRANSPORTATION PROVIDERS

- (1) Inter-provincial land transportation providers are prohibited from transporting and/or renting out their motor vehicles to passengers who exits and/or enters the DKI Jakarta Province during the period of the stipulation of non-natural disasters of the spread of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a national disaster.
- (2) Excluded from the provisions as referred to in paragraph (1), for passengers who have SIKM.
- (3) Inter-provincial land transportation providers that violate the prohibition as referred to in paragraph (1) shall be subject to sanctions:
 - a. administrative fine in the amount of Rp10,000,000 (ten million rupiah); or
 - b. towing into a motor vehicle storage facility provided by the DKI Jakarta Provincial Government.
- (4) In carrying out the towing, the Transportation Service Office shall not be responsible for the completeness and wholeness of the motor vehicle.
- (5) After the vehicle is towed, the Transportation Service Office shall deliver a written notification to the inter-provincial land transportation providers within 1 x 24 (one times twenty-four) hours to retrieve the vehicle.
- (6) In addition to the imposition of sanctions as referred to in paragraph (3), the Transportation Service Office may issue a recommendation to revoke a business license for inter-provincial land transportation providers to the Ministry of Transportation of the Republic of Indonesia.
- (7) The imposition of sanctions as referred to in paragraph (3) shall be carried out by the Transportation Service Office with the assistance of Satpol PP and may include elements of the Police Force and the TNI.



Article 16

- (1) Administrative fines as referred to in Article 15 paragraph (3) must be deposited into the regional treasury.
- (2) With respect to administrative fines as referred to in paragraph (1), SKDA-PKB shall be issued by the Transportation Service Office based on evidence of violations and given to the violators to be deposited into the regional treasury through Bank DKI.
- (3) Photocopy of deposit certificate from Bank DKI by the violator shall be submitted to the Transportation Service officer at the Office of the City Administration's Transportation Service of in the area where the violation happened.

CHAPTER VII

FINANCING

Article 17

The costs required to conduct supervision and enforcement of violations of restrictions on travel activities in exiting/entering the DKI Jakarta Province as referred to in this Governor Regulation, shall be sourced from the Regional Revenue and Expenditures Budget (*Anggaran Pendapatan dan Belanja Daerah* or APBD) and/or other legal sources and are not binding according to the laws and regulations.



CHAPTER VIII

CLOSING PROVISIONS

Article 18

This Governor Regulation shall come into force on the date of its enactment.

For public cognizance, this Governor Regulation shall be promulgated by including it in the Regional Gazette of the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province.
