INSTRUCTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

NUMBER 6 OF 2020

REGARDING

**INCREASE IN HEALTH PROTOCOL DISCIPLINE AND LAW ENFORCEMENT IN THE
PREVENTION AND HANDLING OF CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019**

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

To ensure legal certainty, to strengthen efforts and to increase the effectiveness of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling in all provinces and regencies/cities in Indonesia, hereby instructs:

To : 1. All Ministers of the Indonesia Maju Cabinet;
2. Cabinet Secretaries;
3. Commander of the Indonesian National Army;
4. Chief of the Indonesian National Police;
5. All Heads of Non-Ministerial Government Agencies;
6. All Governors; and
7. All Regents/Mayors.

To :
FIRST : Take the necessary steps in accordance with their respective duties, functions and authorities in ensuring legal certainty, strengthening efforts and to increase the effectiveness of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling in all provinces and regencies/cities in Indonesia.

SECOND : Specifically To:

1. The Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal, and Security Affairs to:
 - a. Carry out coordination, synchronization, and supervision over the implementation of increased discipline and law enforcement towards violations of health protocol in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling; and
 - b. Report the implementation of this Presidential Instruction to the President at least 1 (one) time in 1 (one) month or at any time if necessary.

2. The Minister of Home Affairs to:
 - a. Carry out massive socialization and dissemination regarding the implementation of health protocol in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling to regional governments and to the public;
 - b. Provide technical guidance to provincial regional governments and regency/city regional governments in drafting governor regulations/regent/mayor regulations;
 - c. Provide assistance to provincial regional governments and regency/city regional governments in drafting governor regulations/regent/mayor regulations;
 - d. Carry out coordination and synchronization of the implementation of increased discipline and law enforcement towards violations of health protocol in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling in province and regency/city areas;
 - e. Report the implementation of their duty to the Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal, and Security Affairs at least 1 (one) time in 1 (one) month or at any time if necessary.

3. The Head of the National Body for Disaster Management as the Head of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force to:

- a. Carry out monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of the imposition of sanctions towards violations of health protocol in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling in province and regency/city areas; and
 - b. Report the implementation of monitoring and evaluation to the Head of the Policy Committee of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and National Economic Recovery Committee at least 1 (one) time in 2 (one) weeks or at any time if necessary.
4. The Commander of the Indonesian National Army to:
- a. Provide support to governors, regents/mayors by mobilizing the strength of the Indonesian National Army to supervise the implementation of health protocol in the society;
 - b. Along with the Chief of the Indonesian National Police and other agencies in an integrated manner with the regional government to intensify patrols of the implementation of health protocol in the society; and
 - c. Conduct public guidance to participate in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling.
5. The Chief of the Indonesian National Police to:
- a. Provide support to governors, regents/mayors by mobilizing the strength of the Indonesian National Police to supervise the implementation of health protocol in society;
 - b. Along with the Commander of the Indonesian National Army and other agencies in an integrated manner with the regional government to intensify patrols of the implementation of health protocol in society;
 - c. Conduct public guidance to participate in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling; and
 - d. Effectuate law enforcement efforts against violations of health protocol.

6. All Governors, Regents and Mayors to:
 - a. Massively increase the socialization of the implementation of health protocols in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling by involving the public, religious leaders, community leaders and other elements of society;
 - b. Draft and stipulate governor regulations/regent/mayor regulations which contain, among others:
 - 1) The obligation to comply with health protocol among others, including:
 - a. individual health protection which includes:
 - (1) using personal protective equipment in the form of a mask that covers the nose and mouth to the chin, if you have to leave the house or interact with other people whose health status is unknown;
 - (2) cleaning hands regularly;
 - (3) physical distancing; and
 - (4) increasing bodily immunity by applying Clean and Healthy Living Behavior (PHBS or *Perilaku Hidup Bersih dan Sehat*);
 - b. public health protection which includes:
 - (1) socialization, education, and use of various information media to provide understanding and comprehension regarding Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling;
 - (2) provision of means of hand washing using soap that is easily accessible and meets standards or the provision of hand sanitizer
 - (3) health screening and monitoring efforts for everyone who will be doing activities;

- (4) efforts to regulate distance;
 - (5) periodic cleaning and disinfection of the premises;
 - (6) enforcement of discipline in community behavior that is at risk of transmitting and contracting the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); and
 - (7) facilitation in early detection and handling of cases to anticipate the spread of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- 2) The obligation to comply with health protocol in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling as referred to in point 1) is imposed individuals, business actors, managers, organizers or persons in charge of public places and facilities.
- 3) Public places and facilities as referred to in point 2), include:
 - a) offices/workplaces, businesses, and industries;
 - b) schools/other educational institutions;
 - c) places of worship;
 - d) stations, terminals, ports and airports;
 - e) public transportation;
 - f) personal vehicles;
 - g) stores, modern markets and traditional markets;
 - h) apothecaries and pharmacies;
 - i) food stalls, dining places, cafes, and restaurants;
 - j) street vendors/hawker stalls;
 - k) hotels/other similar accommodation;
 - l) tourism places;
 - m) health service facilities;

- n) public areas, other places that can cause large crowds;
- o) public places and facilities in other health protocol in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations;
- 4) Individuals, business actors, managers, organizers or persons in charge of public places and facilities as referred to in point 2), are required to facilitate the implementation of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling.
- 5) Contain sanctions for violations of the implementation of health protocol in Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling by individuals, business actors, managers, organizers or persons in charge of public places and facilities.
- 6) Sanctions as referred to in point 5) are in the form of:
 - a) verbal warning or written warning;
 - b) social work;
 - c) administrative fines; or
 - d) suspension or temporary closure of business operations
- 7) Contains provisions relating to the provision of infrastructure and facilities for Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling;
- 8) Contains provisions relating to socializations in the form of information/education facilities on Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) prevention and handling;
- 9) Involves the participation of the public, religious leaders, community leaders and other elements of society.
- c. In the drafting and stipulation of governor regulations/regent/mayor regulations as referred to in

letter b, consider and adjust in accordance with the local wisdom of each region; and

- d. In implementation, imposition of governor regulation/regent/mayor regulation sanctions, coordinate with the relevant Ministries/Agencies, the Indonesian National Army, and the Indonesian National Police.

THIRD : All costs required to carry out this Presidential Instruction are charged to the State Revenue and Expenditure Budget, the Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget, and other legitimate sources that are non-binding in accordance with laws and regulations.

FOURTH : To carry out this Presidential Instruction with full responsibility.

This Presidential Instruction shall be effective since the date of its issuance.
