NUMBER 82 OF 2020

REGARDING

CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) HANDLING AND NATIONAL ECONOMIC
RECOVERY COMMITTEE

WITH THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

- Considering :
- a. whereas the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has affected the social, economic and welfare aspects of society;
 - b. whereas the handling handling of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic cannot be separated from national economic recovery efforts because the impact of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has caused a decrease in various economic activities which endangers the national economy;
 - c. whereas based on the consideration as referred to in letter b, the handling of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and national economic recovery must be carried out in a single unified strategic policy, which is integrated and cannot be separated;
 - d. whereas the handling of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and national economic recovery must be carried out in one institution;
 - e. whereas based on the considerations as referred to in letter a, letter b, letter c, and letter d it is necessary to stipulate Presidential Regulation regarding the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Handling and National Economic Recovery Committee;

Bearing in Mind : Article 4 paragraph (1) of the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia;

HAS DECIDED:

To Stipulate : PRESIDENTIAL REGULATION REGARDING CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) HANDLING AND NATIONAL ECONOMIC RECOVERY COMMITTEE.

Article 1

- (1) In order to accelerate the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) handling as well as national economic recovery and transformation, the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and National Economic Recovery Committee is established which hereinafter referred to as the Committee.
- (2) The Committee is under the supervision and is responsible to the President.

Article 2

The Committee as referred to in Article 1 consists of:

- a. Policy Committee;
- b. COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit; and
- c. National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit.

Article 3

- (1) The Policy Committee as referred to in Article 2 letter a has the duties of:
 - a. formulating strategic policy recommendations to the President in the acceleration of COVID-19 handling as well as national economic recovery and economic transformation;

- b. integrating and stipulating implementation steps of strategic policy as well as breakthroughs that are needed for the acceleration of COVID-19 handling as well as national economic recovery and economic transformation; and
- c. conducting monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of strategic policy in the acceleration of COVID-19 handling as well as national economic recovery and economic transformation.

(2) The membership structure of the Policy Committee as referred to in paragraph (1) consists of:

- a. Chairperson : Coordinating Minister of Economic Affairs;
- b. Deputy Chairperson I : Coordinating Minister of Maritime and Investment Affairs;
- c. Deputy Chairperson II : Coordinating Minister of Political, Law, and Security Affairs;
- d. Deputy Chairperson III : Coordinating Minister of Human Development and Culture;
- e. Deputy Chairperson IV : Minister of Finance;
- f. Deputy Chairperson V : Minister of Health;
- g. Deputy Chairperson VI : Minister of Home Affairs;
- h. Chief Executive : Minister of State-Owned Enterprises;
- i. Executive Secretary I : Mr. Raden Pardede;
- j. Executive Secretary II : Secretary of the Coordinating Ministry of Economic Affairs.

Article 4

The Chief Executive as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (2) letter h has the duty to integrate and coordinate the implementation of strategic policy in the acceleration of COVID-19 handling as well as national economic recovery and economic transformation.

Article 5

- (1) In carrying out their duties, the Policy Committee is assisted by the Policy Committee Secretariat.
- (2) The Policy Committee Secretariat is jointly chaired by:
 - a. Executive Secretary I for program affairs; and
 - b. Executive Secretary II for administrative affairs.
- (3) Details regarding the duties and membership structure of the Policy Committee Secretariat as referred to in paragraph (1) shall be stipulated by the Chairperson of the Policy Committee.

Article 6

The COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit as referred to in Article 2 letter b has the duties of:

- a. conducting and controlling the implementation of strategic policy relating to COVID-19 handling;
- b. resolving problems in implementing strategic policy relating to COVID-19 handling in a quick and accurate manner;
- c. conducting supervision of the implementation of strategic policy relating to COVID-19 handling; and
- d. stipulating and implementing policy as well as other necessary steps in accelerating COVID-19 handling.

Article 7

The COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit as referred to in Article 2 letter b is chaired by the Head of the National Body for Disaster Management.

Article 8

The National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit as referred to in Article 2 letter c has the duties of:

- a. conducting and controlling the implementation of strategic policy relating to national economic recovery and transformation;
- b. resolving problems in implementing strategic policy relating to national economic recovery and transformation, including problems faced by real business sectors quickly and accurately;
- c. conducting supervision of the implementation of strategic policy relating to national economic recovery and transformation; and
- d. stipulating and implementing policy as well as other necessary steps in accelerating national economic recovery and transformation.

Article 9

The National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit as referred to in Article 2 letter c is chaired by the Vice Minister of State-Owned Enterprises I.

Article 10

In carrying out duties as referred to in Article 6 and Article 8, COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit and the National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit:

- a. has the authority to stipulate decisions that bind ministries/institutions, regional governments and other government institutions; and

- b. carries out communication and coordination with the relevant ministries/institutions and regional governments.

Article 11

- (1) The COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit as referred to in Article 2 letter b and the National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit as referred to in Article 2 letter c consists of government elements and other necessary elements.
- (2) The membership structure and the organization structure of the Task Force Unit as referred to in article (1) is stipulated by the Chairperson of the Policy Committee.

Article 12

- (1) Governors and Regents/Mayors shall form Regional COVID-19 Handling Task Force Units based on considerations and recommendations from the Head of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit.
- (2) COVID-19 handling in the region is carried out while observing the instructions of the Head of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit.

Article 13

The Committee as referred to in Article 1, in carrying out its duties may involve ministries, institutions, agencies, regional governments, businesses, experts, academics, and other necessary parties.

Article 14

The Chairperson of the Policy Committee reports the implementation of their duties to the President periodically every 3 (three) months or at any time if needed.

Article 15

- (1) The Head of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit composes and submits a routine daily report to the President and the Chairperson of the Policy Committee.
- (2) The Head of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit submits an urgent incident report to the President and the Chairperson of the Policy Committee at any time if needed.

Article 16

The Chairperson of the National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit reports the implementation of their duties to the President and the Chairperson of the Policy Committee periodically every 1 (one) month or at any time if needed.

Article 17

Ministries/institutions, regional provincial governments and regional regency/city governments supports the implementation of Committee activities in accordance with their respective authorities.

Article 18

All costs required in the carrying out of Policy Committee, COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit, National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit and Policy Committee Secretariat duties are charged to:

- a. state revenue and expenditure budget;
- b. regional revenue and expenditure budget; and/or
- c. other legitimate and non-binding sources in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulation.

Article 19

- (1) With the formation of the Committee as referred to in Article 1, through this Presidential Regulation the following are dissolved:

- a. Extractive Industry Transparency Team established based on Presidential Regulation Number 26 of 2010 regarding Transparency of State Revenue and Regional Revenue Obtained from Extractive Industries;
- b. National Coordinating Body for Counseling on Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry established based on Presidential Regulation Number 10 of 2011 regarding National Coordinating Body for Counseling on Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry;
- c. 2011-2025 Indonesian Economic Development Acceleration and Expansion Committee established based on Presidential Regulation Number 32 of 2011 regarding Masterplan for 2011-2025 Indonesian Economy Development Acceleration and Expansion as amended by Presidential Regulation Number 48 of 2014 regarding Amendments to Presidential Regulation Number 32 of 2011 regarding Masterplan for 2011-2025 Indonesian Economy Development Acceleration and Expansion;
- d. Sunda Strait Infrastructure and Strategic Area Development Body established based on Presidential Regulation Number 86 of 2011 regarding Sunda Strait Infrastructure and Strategic Area Development;
- e. Mangrove Ecosystem Management National Coordination Team established based on Presidential Regulation Number 73 of 2012 regarding Mangrove Ecosystem Management National Strategy;
- f. Improvement of Drinking Water Supply System Body established based on Presidential Regulation Number 90 of 2016 regarding Improvement of Drinking Water Supply System Body;
- g. E-Commerce Roadmap Steering Committee of 2017-2019 established based on Presidential Regulation Number 74 of 2017 regarding E-Commerce Roadmap of 2017-2019;
- h. Task Force for the Acceleration of the Implementation of Business established based Presidential Decree Number 91 of 2017 regarding the Acceleration of the Implementation of Business;
- i. Coordination Team for Monitoring and Evaluation of Granting Guarantees and Interest Subsidies to PDAM in the Acceleration of Supplying Drinking Water formed based on Presidential Regulation Number 46 of 2019 regarding

Granting Guarantees and Interest Subsidies to the Central Government in the Acceleration of Supplying Drinking Water;

- j. Overseas Commercial Loan Team established based on Presidential Decree Number 39 of 1991 regarding Coordination of Overseas Commercial Loans Management;
- k. National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization established based on Presidential Decree Number 104 of 1999 regarding Formation of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 16 of 2002 regarding Second Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 104 of 1999 regarding Formation of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization;
- l. Restructuring and Rehabilitation Team for PT (Persero) *Perusahaan Listrik Negara* established based on Presidential Decree Number 166 of 1999 regarding Restructuring and Rehabilitation Team for PT (Persero) *Perusahaan Listrik Negara* as amended by Presidential Decree Number 133 of 2000 regarding the Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 166 of 1999 regarding Restructuring and Rehabilitation Team for PT (Persero) *Perusahaan Listrik Negara*;
- m. Policy Committee in the Financial Sector established based on Presidential Decree Number 177 of 1999 regarding Policy Committee in the Financial Sector as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 53 of 2003 regarding the Second Amendment of Presidential Decree Number 177 of 1999 regarding Policy Committee in the Financial Sector;
- n. Inter-Department Committee in the Field of Forestry established based on Presidential Decree Number 80 of 2000 regarding Inter-Department Committee in the Field of Forestry;
- o. Coordination Team for Increasing the Smooth Flow of Export and Import Goods established based on Presidential Decree Number 54 of 2002 regarding Coordination Team to Increase the Smooth Flow of Export and Import Goods as amended by Presidential Decree Number 24 of 2005 regarding Coordination Team to Increase the Smooth Flow of Export and Import Goods;

- p. National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments established based on Presidential Decree Number 3 of 2006 regarding National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 28 of 2010 regarding Second Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 3 of 2006 regarding National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments;
 - q. Coordination Team for Accelerating the Construction of Apartments in Urban Areas established based on Presidential Decree Number 22 of 2006 regarding Coordination Team for Accelerating the Construction of Apartments in Urban Areas; and
 - r. National Committee for the Preparation of the Implementation of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Economic Community established based on Presidential Decree Number 37 of 2014 regarding National Committee for the Preparation of the Implementation of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Economic Community.
- (2) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter h, letter p, and letter r, the implementation of the duties and functions of the:
- a. Task Force for the Acceleration of the Implementation of Business established based Presidential Decree Number 91 of 2017 regarding the Acceleration of the Implementation of Business;
 - b. National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments established based on Presidential Decree Number 3 of 2006 regarding National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 28 of 2010 regarding Second Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 3 of 2006 regarding National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments; and
 - c. National Committee for the Preparation of the Implementation of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Economic Community established based on Presidential Decree Number 37 of 2014 regarding National Committee for the Preparation of the Implementation of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Economic Community.

are conducted by the Policy Committee and/or National Economic Recovery and Transformation Task Force Unit in accordance with their respective duties and authorities as regulated in this Presidential Regulation.

- (3) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter a, the implementation of the duties and functions of the Extractive Industry Transparency Team established based on Presidential Regulation Number 26 of 2010 regarding Transparency of State Revenue and Regional Revenue Obtained from Extractive Industries, is conducted by the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources and the Ministry of Finance in accordance with their respective duties and functions.
- (4) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter b, the implementation of the duties and functions of the National Coordinating Body for Counseling on Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry established based on Presidential Regulation Number 10 of 2011 regarding National Coordinating Body for Counseling on Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, is conducted by the Ministry of Environment and Forestry, Ministry of Agriculture, and Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries in accordance with their respective duties and functions.
- (5) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter e, the implementation of the duties and functions of the Mangrove Ecosystem Management National Coordination Team established based on Presidential Regulation Number 73 of 2012 regarding Mangrove Ecosystem Management National Strategy, is conducted by the Ministry of Environment and Forestry and Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries in accordance with their respective duties and functions.
- (6) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter f and letter q, the implementation of the duties and functions:
 - a. Improvement of Drinking Water Supply System Body established based on Presidential Regulation Number 90 of 2016 regarding Improvement of Drinking Water Supply System Body; and
 - b. Coordination Team for Accelerating the Construction of Apartments in Urban Areas established based on Presidential Decree Number 22 of 2006 regarding Coordination Team for Accelerating the Construction of Apartments in Urban Areas,is conducted by the Ministry of Public Works and Public Housing.
- (7) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter i, the implementation of the duties and functions of the Coordination Team for Monitoring and Evaluation of Granting Guarantees and Interest Subsidies to PDAM in the Acceleration of Supplying Drinking Water established based on Presidential Regulation Number 46

of 2019 regarding Granting Guarantees and Interest Subsidies to the Central Government in the Acceleration of Supplying Drinking Water, is conducted by the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Public Works and Public Housing in accordance with their respective duties and functions.

- (8) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter j, the implementation of the duties and functions of the Overseas Commercial Loan Team established based on Presidential Decree Number 39 of 1991 regarding Coordination of Overseas Commercial Loans Management, is conducted by the Ministry Finance.
- (9) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter k, the implementation of the duties and functions of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization formed based on Presidential Decree Number 104 of 1999 regarding Formation of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 16 of 2002 regarding Second Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 104 of 1999 regarding Formation of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization, is conducted by the Ministry of Trade and Ministry of Foreign Affairs in accordance with their respective duties and functions.
- (10) With the dissolution as referred to in paragraph (1) letter n, the implementation of the duties and functions of the Inter-Department Committee in the Field of Forestry established based on Presidential Decree Number 80 of 2000 regarding Inter-Department Committee in the Field of Forestry, is conducted by the Ministry of Environment and Forestry.

Article 20

- (1) By this Presidential Regulation:
 - a. Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19 established based on Presidential Decree Number 7 of 2020 regarding Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as amended by Presidential Decree Number 9 of 2020 regarding Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 7 of 2020 regarding Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) ; and
 - b. Regional Task Force for the Acceleration of COVID-19 Handling that is established by the Governor and Regent/Mayor, continue to conduct their

duties, functions, and authorities until the membership of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit and Regional COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit is established and stipulated in accordance with the terms of this Presidential Regulation.

- (2) Since the establishment and stipulation of the members of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit and Regional COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit as referred to in paragraph (1):
- a. Presidential Decree Number 7 of 2020 regarding Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as amended by Presidential Decree Number 9 of 2020 regarding Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 7 of 2020 regarding Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) , is revoked and no longer deemed applicable;
 - b. Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19 and the Regional Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19 as referred to in paragraph (1) is dissolved; and
 - c. implementation of the duties and functions of the Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19 and Regional Task Force for the Acceleration of Handling COVID-19 as referred to in paragraph (1), are subsequently conducted by the Policy Committee and/or COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit/Regional COVID-19 Handling Task Force Unit in accordance with their respective duties and authorities as regulated in this Presidential Regulation.

Article 21

When this Presidential Regulation comes into force:

- a. Presidential Regulation Number 26 of 2010 regarding Transparency of State Revenue and Regional Revenue Obtained from Extractive Industries;
- b. Presidential Regulation Number 10 of 2011 regarding National Coordinating Body for Counseling on Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry;
- c. Presidential Regulation Number 32 of 2011 regarding Masterplan for 2011-2025 Indonesian Economy Development Acceleration and Expansion as amended by

- Presidential Regulation Number 48 of 2014 regarding Amendments to Presidential Regulation Number 32 of 2011 regarding Masterplan for 2011-2025 Indonesian Economy Development Acceleration and Expansion;
- d. Presidential Regulation Number 86 of 2011 regarding Sunda Strait Infrastructure and Strategic Area Development;
 - e. Mangrove Ecosystem Management National Coordination Team formed based on Presidential Regulation Number 73 of 2012 regarding Mangrove Ecosystem Management National Strategy;
 - f. Presidential Regulation Number 90 of 2016 regarding Improvement of Drinking Water Supply System Body;
 - g. Presidential Regulation Number 74 of 2017 regarding E-Commerce Roadmap of 2017-2019;
 - h. Presidential Regulation Number of 91 of 2017 regarding Acceleration of the Implementation of Business;
 - i. Presidential Decree Number 39 of 1991 regarding Coordination of Overseas Commercial Loans Management;
 - j. Presidential Decree Number 104 of 1999 regarding Formation of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 16 of 2002 regarding Second Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 104 of 1999 regarding Formation of the National Team for Multilateral Trade Negotiations in the Framework of the World Trade Organization;
 - k. Presidential Decree Number 166 of 1999 regarding Restructuring and Rehabilitation Team for PT (Persero) *Perusahaan Listrik Negara* as amended by Presidential Decree Number 133 of 2000 regarding the Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 166 of 1999 regarding Restructuring and Rehabilitation Team for PT (Persero) *Perusahaan Listrik Negara*;
 - l. Presidential Decree Number 177 of 1999 regarding Policy Committee in the Financial Sector as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 53 of 2003 regarding the Second Amendment of Presidential Decree Number 177 of 1999 regarding Policy Committee in the Financial Sector;

- m. Presidential Decree Number 80 of 2000 regarding Inter-Department Committee in the Field of Forestry;
- n. Presidential Decree Number 54 of 2002 regarding Coordination Team to Increase the Smooth Flow of Export and Import Goods as amended by Presidential Decree Number 24 of 2005 regarding Coordination Team to Increase the Smooth Flow of Export and Import Goods;
- o. Presidential Decree Number 3 of 2006 regarding National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments as amended several times, lastly amended by Presidential Decree Number 28 of 2010 regarding Second Amendment to Presidential Decree Number 3 of 2006 regarding National Team for Increasing Export and Increasing Investments;
- p. Presidential Decree Number 22 of 2006 regarding Coordination Team for Accelerating the Construction of Apartments in Urban Areas; and
- q. Presidential Decree Number 37 of 2014 regarding National Committee for the Preparation of the Implementation of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Economic Community;

are revoked and no longer deemed applicable.

Article 22

This Presidential Regulation shall come into force on the date of promulgation.

For public cognizance, this Presidential Regulation shall be promulgated by including it in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
