Subject : Temporary Restrictions on the Entry of Travelers

To the Region of Indonesia

Following up on the dynamics of the COVID-19 Pandemic in India as stated on the World Health Organization website (https://covid19.who.int/region/searo/country/in), we respectfully convey as follows:

- 1. In the context of preventing the Imported Case of Covid-19, the Immigration Officer at the Immigration Checkpoint refuses entry to foreigners who have a traveling history from the region of India within 14 (fourteen) days before entering the region of Indonesia;
- 2. The granting of visit visas and limited stay visas to Indian citizens are temporarily suspended;
- 3. For Indonesian citizens who have a traveling history from the region of India within 14 (fourteen) days before entering the region of Indonesia, they can only enter through:
  - a. Soekarno-Hatta Airport Immigration Checkpoint (*Tempat Pemeriksaan Imigrasi* or TPI) in Tangerang;

- b. Juanda Airport TPI in Surabaya;
- c. Kualanamu Airport TPI in Medan;
- d. Sam Ratulangi Airport TPI in Manado;
- e. Batam Center Seaport TPI in Batam;
- f. Sri Bintan Pura Seaport TPI in Tanjung Pinang; and
- g. Dumai Seaport TPI in Dumai.
- 4. This policy shall come into force on April 24, 2021 and will be further evaluated.
